In February 2006 one of the most horrific cases of animal abuse was brought to our attention after an incident occurred on Handsworth Golf Course in Birmingham, England.

A Staffordshire Bull Terrier was doused in a flammable liquid and ignited. The injuries were fatal. Death being a particularly agonizing experience for this poor creature.



Many lovers of the breed have contacted us already asking what can be done.

At a meeting in Carlisle on Sunday 26th February 2006 it was decided that a fund should be set up with a view to offering it as a reward to present to anybody who can give the information that the Police need to secure a conviction for this heinous crime.
